Topics of instruction include instructor development, use of force and liability issues, the different types of munitions and launchers currently available, tactical considerations, deployment procedures, suggested less lethal policy concerns, medical issues and proper documentation. During this course, students will be required to prepare a short lesson plan and demonstrate their ability to instruct others within a classroom setting.
