# ***DIVERSIONARY DEVICE INSTRUCTOR'S COURSE***

**(Calif. POST Plan IV)**

**Hosted by the Riverside Police Department**

### **DESCRIPTION**

This two day comprehensive course will develop students as agency instructors in the use of diversionary devices. It is only open to tactical team personnel designated by their agency as diversionary device instructors. Topics of instruction include history & physics of diversionary devices, types of devices, general characteristics, effects on the human body, pre-deployment concerns, criteria for use, proper deployment techniques, tactical considerations, liability concerns, rendering safe, reloading, documentation, instructional techniques and other related topics. Students will be required to prepare a short lesson plan and demonstrate the ability to instruct others within a classroom setting. Students will also have to pass a written test as well as demonstrate proficiency with their agency's approved diversionary devices. POST Control # 1076-21920-08002

### **EQUIPMENT.**

First Day: Casual Clothes. Second Day: Nomex, leather (or similar heavy duty material) gloves, body armor/tactical vest with diversionary device pouches, ballistic helmet (preferably with face shield), duty boots, five (5) diversionary devices per student, two (2) training bangs per student (the latter may be purchased from NTC for \$15 each plus tax), hearing protection, wrap-around eye protection, note taking material. Nomex flight suits (or other similar clothing) are suggested.

NTC Course certifications do not have specific time limit. Students are encouraged to maintain their skills and knowledge. To help accomplish this, it is N.T.C.'s policy that based on availability, past students in good standing be allowed to attend future NTC courses in the same discipline at no additional cost. Please note that in agreement with the ATF, all Diversionary Device manufacturers now only sell these devices to law enforcement agencies whose department instructors have a current certificate from either one of the manufacturer training programs or a POST certified diversionary device instructor course.
